

1) Gaußscher Integralsatz

a) Quellenstärke eines Vektorfeldes $\vec{F} = \begin{pmatrix} F_x \\ F_y \\ F_z \end{pmatrix}$ als Hülleinintegral über differentiellen Fluss dQ .


$$Q = \int \limits_{\Sigma} dQ$$



$$dQ = \vec{F} \cdot d\vec{\Gamma}$$

$$\Rightarrow Q = \int \limits_{\Sigma} \vec{F} \cdot d\vec{\Gamma}$$

b) Quellenstärke als Volumenintegral über differentielle Hülle



$$d\vec{\Gamma}_x = -dy \cdot dz \begin{pmatrix} 1 \\ 0 \\ 0 \end{pmatrix}$$

$$d\vec{\Gamma}_y = -dx \cdot dz \begin{pmatrix} 0 \\ 1 \\ 0 \end{pmatrix}$$

$$d\vec{\Gamma}_z = -dx \cdot dy \begin{pmatrix} 0 \\ 0 \\ 1 \end{pmatrix}$$

$$F_x + dx = F_x + \frac{\partial F_x}{\partial x} dx$$

$$F_y + dy = F_y + \frac{\partial F_y}{\partial y} dy$$

$$F_z + dz = F_z + \frac{\partial F_z}{\partial z} dz$$

$$dQ_x = -dy dz F_x$$

$$dQ_y = -dx dz F_y$$

$$dQ_z = -dx dy F_z$$

$$dQ_{x+dx} = dy dz F_x + \frac{\partial F_x}{\partial x} dx dy dz$$

$$dQ_{y+dy} = dx dz F_y + \frac{\partial F_y}{\partial y} dy dx dz$$

$$dQ_{z+dz} = dx dy F_z + \frac{\partial F_z}{\partial z} dz dx dy$$

$$dQ = dQ_x + dQ_y + dQ_z + dQ_{x+dx} + dQ_{y+dy} + dQ_{z+dz}$$

$$= \left(\frac{\partial F_x}{\partial x} + \frac{\partial F_y}{\partial y} + \frac{\partial F_z}{\partial z} \right) dx dy dz$$

$$= \begin{pmatrix} \frac{\partial F_x}{\partial x} \\ \frac{\partial F_y}{\partial y} \\ \frac{\partial F_z}{\partial z} \end{pmatrix} \cdot \vec{F} \cdot dV = \nabla \cdot \vec{F} dV$$

$$\Rightarrow Q = \int \limits_{\Sigma} \nabla \cdot \vec{F} dV$$

$$\boxed{\int \limits_{\Sigma} \vec{F} \cdot d\vec{\Gamma} = \int \limits_{\Sigma} \nabla \cdot \vec{F} dV}$$

2) 2. Greensche Identität, setze

$$\vec{F} = g \nabla p - p \nabla g \quad \text{in Gaußscher Integralform ein}$$

$$\begin{aligned} \int_{\partial\Omega} (g \nabla p - p \nabla g) \cdot d\vec{\Gamma} &= \int_{\Omega} \nabla(g \nabla p - p \nabla g) dV \\ &= \int_{\Omega} (\nabla g \nabla p + g \nabla^2 p - \nabla p \nabla g - p \nabla^2 g) dV \\ &= \int_{\Omega} (g \nabla^2 p - p \nabla^2 g) dV \end{aligned}$$

3. Greensche Identität,

Kirchhoff - Helmholtz - Integral :

setze ... $(\nabla^2 + k^2) p = 0 \Rightarrow \nabla^2 p = -k^2 p$... homogenes Schallfeld

und ... $(\nabla^2 + k^2) g = -\delta(\vec{r} - \vec{r}_0) \Rightarrow \nabla^2 g = -k^2 g - \delta(\vec{r} - \vec{r}_0)$

... Greensche Funktion
(inhomogenes Schallfeld,
Quellenfeld d. Punktquelle)

rechte Seite d. 2. Greenschen Identität:

$$\int_{\Omega} (g \nabla^2 p - p \nabla^2 g) dV = \int_{\Omega} (-g k^2 p + p k^2 g + p \delta(\vec{r} - \vec{r}_0)) dV$$

$$= p$$

$$\Rightarrow \boxed{p = \int_{\partial\Omega} (g \nabla p - p \nabla g) \cdot d\vec{\Gamma}}$$

$$= \int_{\partial\Omega} \left(g \frac{\partial}{\partial \vec{n}} p - p \frac{\partial}{\partial \vec{n}} g \right) \cdot d\vec{\Gamma}$$
